It was a superbly entertaining encounter with Mike O'Neill deservedly getting the nod for Man of the Match and great contributions by Eric Burns, Ian Galvin, Brendan O'Sullivan and Morgan O'Donoghue. John Cremin and Adrian O'Sullivan covered some great ground and were everywhere when it counted.

The three Macs gave their usual dependable performances and it was good to see David Mac coming through after his return from a bad shoulder injury. Kevin O'Sullivan and Michael White were stuck in from the start and can be proud of a job well done. Denis O'Sullivan was menacing at full forward and looks to have found his best position, however when he was asked to go out the field and win ball he did this to great effect.

Ray White led from the front tearing into every ball and kicking a crucial score in the second half to keep us on the front foot. The going was tough and the ground heavy and the introduction of Ronan Hussey, Donal Galvin and Ian Casey were crucial to getting fresh legs on the field and also bringing in great ball winners. Great to see Ronan Hussey back on the football field, it certainly gave his teammates a lift when he came on with 10 mins to go in normal time.

The final play of the game epitomised this with the kick out from the ever reliable Richard White finding Donal Galvin who was fouled, a quick free to the open Paudie Mac who was quick to spot the open space, he tore up the field and while the Moyvane backs assumed it would be kicked into either Ian Galvin or Ronan Hussey, Paudie slipped it to Eric Burns who drifted across the 40 and kicked a monster point at the death to win it. A relieved and jubilant Kieran Mac led the celebrations and in fairness Kieran, Joe and Tony made all the right moves on a day when Sneem/Derrynane deserved their victory.



Dog Fouling

Dog fouling is becoming an unsightly and dangerous problem within the village, on the pavements, the greens and in the Garden of the Senses. This is a serious health and safety issue. Also our children when playing on the grass are particularly vulnerable and are at risk of getting one of the many infectious diseases associated with dog faeces. It can cause stomach upsets and more dangerous complaints like toxocariasis. Some responsible dog owners have been observed picking up their dogs litter with a suitable bag, we ask that all dog owners follow their example. It is a fineable offence, under section 22 of the Litter Pollution Act 1997 to not pick up your dog litter. The County Council have provided Sneem with two anti-dog litter signs which have a container for dog litter bags. We urge all dog owners to please avail of these and be responsible and considerate dog owners and get into the habit of bringing a bag when you are taking your dog for a walk. 
