## Kenmare & District Garden Club

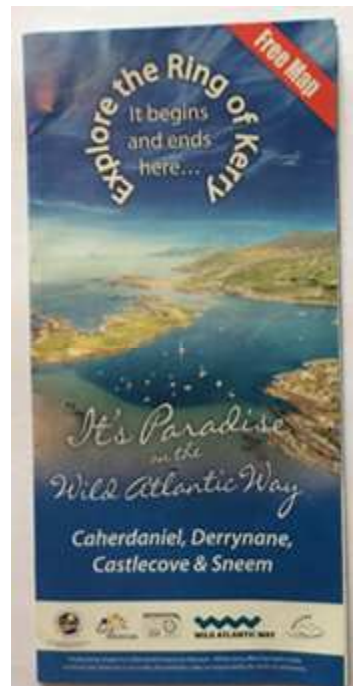

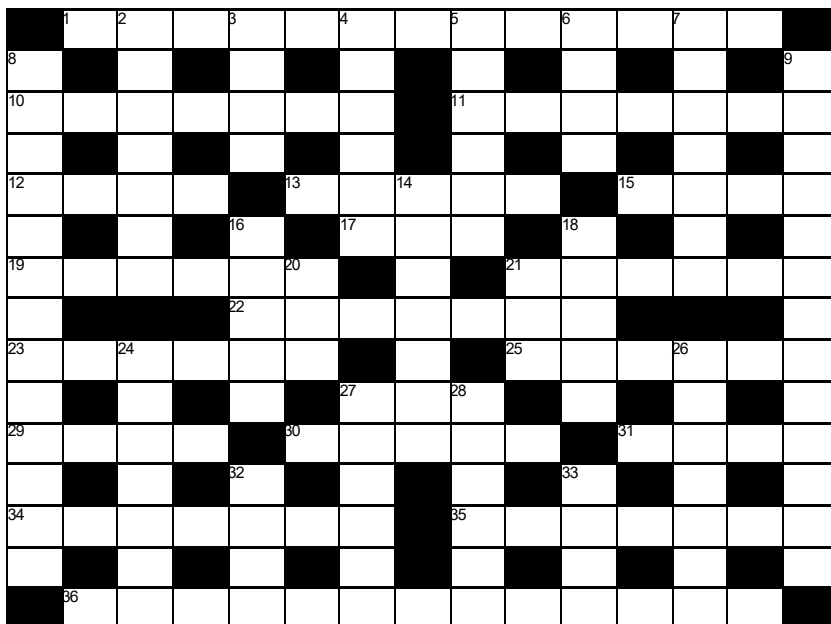

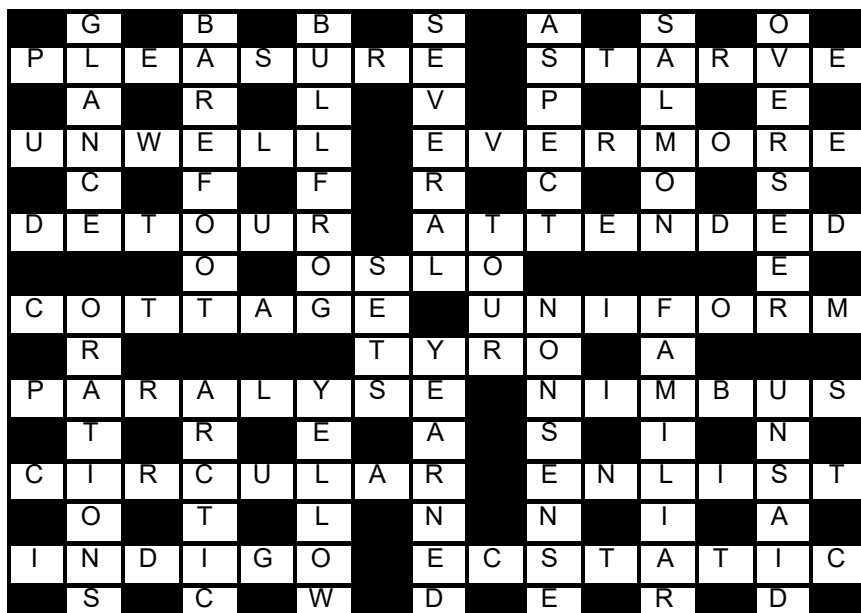
