Have you considered going to Belfast to Kingsbridge Hospital under the Cross Border Directive?

I wish to highlight a few questions people have asked me in the past few weeks:-

- **Do you need health Insurance to use this service?** Answer No
- **Must I pay for this myself?**
Initially yes but the HSE refund the money once you return home afterwards
- **How much does it cost?**
Cataract operation £1500, Hip/Knee replacement £9850 and the HSE reimburse this amount once you return home
- **What is involved in the trip to Belfast on the bus to have my cataract removed?**
Leave Kerry Friday Morning and return home on Saturday evening
- **How long will I be waiting to be called for operation?**
Literally a few weeks
- **Can I travel up myself to have a cataract removed?**
Yes this also possible and can be booked direct with the Hospital
- **Is there an overnight stay involved for Cataract removal?**
Yes but one night in a near by hotel at your own expense
- **How long will I be in Hospital for knee/hip replacement?**
3- 4 nights depending on recovery

Kenmare and District Garden Club

We had a record attendance at Thursday's meeting, 6th September, when renowned landscaper, Tim Austen gave us a most interesting talk with slides with the intriguing title "Between a Rock and a Hard Place". He showed us many of his projects at varying stages and then on completion and what a difference Before and After! He explained that hard landscaping aspects are equally as important as plants and covered topics such as Garden Walls, Pergolas, Seats, Steps, Lighting and Water and how all or some of them can enhance the outdoor area. Generally people have gardens for the love of plants, for recreation, for expression about themselves and to grow food and in consultation with his clients, he tries to cover what is important to them in the design of their garden using planting as well as hard landscaping. He finished by showing us what he and his wife are planning for their site in Wicklow and to say it's mind-boggling is an understatement! He will certainly be putting all his skill and experience to good use to achieve what they want.

The next gardening club meeting will be on Thursday, 4th October at 7.30 p.m. in the Gateway when we can look forward to a talk by the Head Propagator for Blarney Castle, Rory Newell, entitled "The Propagator's Diary". Sneem Men's Shed

While Kerry sweltered in its heatwave, the members of the Men's Shed continued with their programme of social and practical activity. The whole story of bird nesting boxes was refined with the adoption of a hedgerow and farmer friendly standard design alongside development of a version of an approved bat roosting box that could be simply made, cheaply and in quantity. A pilot sale table at the Sneem Summer Festival successfully exchanged a significant number of products from this exercise for donations to the Shed's general funds.

This project has been greatly facilitated by the acquisition of a Jefferson 12 inch mitre saw with a grant received from Kerry County Council's Community Support Fund. This piece of equipment has had a major impact on the capacity to accurately cut wood for projects. The machine has also contributed to the finishing work on the Sneem Digital Hub, another community project. We are very grateful for this support from Kerry County Council.

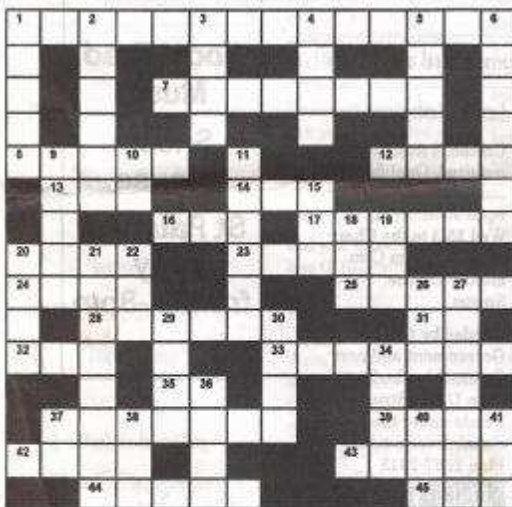
Celebrating 200 Issues!

A quick start saw the great Jimmy O'Brien latch onto a deflected corner kick and buried it in the net after 4 minutes of premium KDL action. After some very neat play and fast counter attacks Sneem won a penalty for a handball on 9 minutes and up stepped fearless Jimmy to coolly slot into the bottom left corner. We had the ball in the net again 10 minutes later when Mike Dennehy assisted with a precision ball into Jimmy to get his hat trick and match ball. We are looking at the bigger picture here, we know that there are young families forced to live elsewhere because of the lack of housing, this is a serious matter, as it will have a 'domino' effect on the village's facilities.
