Road Closure

Kerry County Council has announced there will be temporary road closures in place on the N70 Sneem to Kenmare Road.

This will lead to delays along the route and to arrivals into both Kenmare and into Waterville as the bus travels in each direction.



This will be in effect from

Thursday the 10th of September until Monday 14th September 2026

with the purpose facilitating the replacement of N70 Drimna More Culvert.

This five-day road closure will impact the following road:

Road: N70 Sneem to Kenmare Road in the townlands of Drimna More and Drimna Beg from 500m southeast of Sneem Post Office to Local Road L7543

Departing:

Leaving Waterville – the bus will operate Waterville – Caherdaniel – Castlecove – Sneem and then to Kenmare via the R568 and N71 into Kenmare as per the map above.

Leaving Kenmare – the bus will operate N71 & R568 into Sneem and then onto Castlecove – Caherdaniel to Waterville

In response, TFI Local Link Kerry will put on an additional temporary bus shuttle service in place to service the affected areas along the N70 covering and connecting Parknasilla – Tahilla – Templenoe – Kenmare.

ICRF All Ireland Coastal Rowing Championships 2026

On Friday 14th August, we set off over the county bounds to Bantry in County Cork for a 3 day event at the Irish Coastal Rowing Federation Irish Coastal Rowing Championships.

It was a massive event with over 730 crews entering 60 race categories.

Sneem Rowing Club had 36 crew entries, 41 races, and we got through to 29 finals. We were delighted to come home with 17 medals by Sunday evening, 5 gold, 7 silver and 5 bronze.

Our age groups ranged from under 14 up to master level. We had 12 U14 boys and girls and we are very proud to say that each one of them came home with a medal each in their pockets, our U14 girls receiving 2 medals each. It was such a great achievement for the Club to get 5 gold medals: Heritage U18 Boys, Heritage Open Men, Heritage Men's 800m Sprint, Heritage Open Mixed and 800m Sprint Men.

7 silver medals were Heritage U14 girls, Master Mixed, Heritage U14 Boys B, PreVet Men, Intermediate Men, Master Ladies and Senior Men.

5 Bronze medals went to U21 Men, Heritage Open Ladies, U18 boys, U14 Girls and U14 Boys A.

To top off a fantastic weekend, at the end of Sunday's events, It was announced that we had won the award for "Outstanding Club Of The Tournament". We were so honoured as the club had never won this before. It is a testament to our committee, our crews, our supporters, everyone helping each other and other clubs throughout the weekend. We had a lovely atmosphere in our tents all weekend.

We want to give a big shout out and thank you to our trainers and coxes. All who worked voluntarily for many, many months to ensure our crews were prepped, and ready to take on some very difficult competition. A special thank you to Sean Murphy, who coxed crews in 33 races.

Una O'Neill of Sneem Book Shop spoke about her journey to Sneem and her deep affection for the local community.

Visitors from outside the area also learned about our "Local Perspectives – Stories on Screen" initiative. The evening concluded with a screening of Story House video recordings featuring Sonny Looney recounting Charles de Gaulle's visit to the village, and Timmy O'Sullivan sharing songs of Sneem alongside entertaining GAA tales.

Recipe Corner

Courgette Pistachio Cake with Lemon Syrup Drizzle

Courgettes are in season and one lovely way to do something different with a courgette is to make a very tasty cake from it. Get your organically grown courgettes from The Yellow Shed Sneem.

- Bake 80 grams of pistachios either in a pan or in the oven till they're golden brown. Let them cool and then beat with a rolling pin until they're the size of breadcrumbs.
- Put 170 ml of good olive oil and 225 grams of caster sugar into a bowl and whisk either with a hand mixer or standing mixer until thick and creamy. Add 2 eggs one by one while continuing to whisk on moderately slow speed.
- Now, carefully fold in 200 grams of flour, a pinch of salt, 200 grams of coarsely grated courgettes, the zest of 2 lemons and the pistachios, just so everything is evenly mixed and covered with the oil mix.
- Pour into a greased and lined 450 loaf tin and bake in the oven preheated to 180degC for 65 to 75 minutes, or until an inserted skewer comes out clean.
- Make the drizzle 10 minutes before you take the cake out of the oven by putting 150 grams of caster sugar and the juice of the 2 zested lemons in a pan. Heat it up and keep stirring until the sugar is dissolved.
- When you take the cake out of the oven, prick it all over with the skewer and drizzle the lemon syrup on top. Let the cake cool down before you take it out of the tin.

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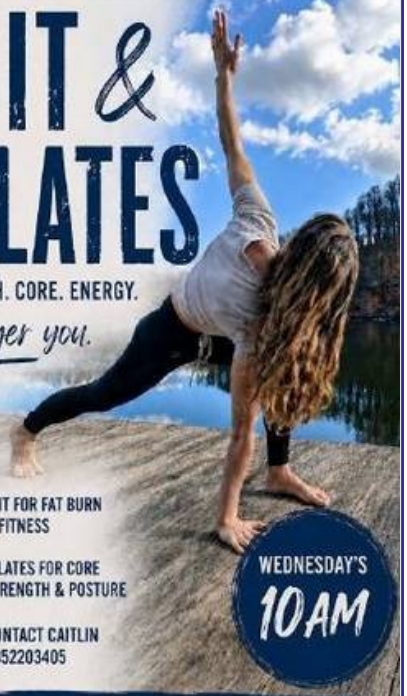
