Award Winners

Irish Food Writers' Guild Award

Congratulations to Peter O'Sullivan Butchers on winning an award in the 2025 Irish Food Writers' Guild Food Awards held on Tuesday 4th March.

Peter O'Sullivan Butchers was singled out for one of just eight awards presented this year by the Irish Food Writers' Guild for its famous Sneem Black Pudding. Now in their 32nd year and with no applications or submissions allowed, all eight winners of the 2025 IFWG Food Awards were chosen based solely on quality, integrity, and a commitment to genuine sustainable practices. The IFWG Food Awards are unique in that no business or individual can enter, nor do they know if they have been nominated for an award. The Guild is the sole nominating and decision-making body* whose members nominate and anonymously buy products for tasting. Proportional representation voting is undertaken at a Guild tasting meeting. Winning products must be produced in Ireland and the main ingredient must be Irish grown or produced.

SneemTidyTowns Working Group AGM

Took place in The Loft at Dan Murphy's Bar on Thursday 20th February. We explained how we are a Working Group operating under Sneem Development Co-operative. We looked back over the projects we were involved in last year, which included Sneem Sally Garden, Sneem River Report, drone shots and contributing to the Outdoor Rainbow Chimes along with Inclusive Sneem in the Garden of the Senses. We ran events including 2 Riverbank Clean-ups with Sneem NS, participated in Kerry Biodiversity Week in May with a Bat Walk, River Sampling with Sneem NS and a Wild Garden Mini-Bioblitz. We worked with Cleancoasts on river cleans and hosted a "think before you flush" stand at the Summer Festival. We held a Heritage Week talk on Sneem River Myths and hosted our second Wild Music in the Wild Garden in September.

We had a successful year of Awards, winning a Kerry Community Awards Silver worth €500; a Silver Medal in National Tidy Towns Competition worth €700; All Ireland Pollinator Award Winner €2000; Community Green Flag Award from Garden of the Senses and a Pollinator Award for Garden of the Senses.

We outlined our proposed projects for 2025, which include:

Ogham Tree Project (Creative Communities Fund*)

- Paint O Dalaigh Memorial (CSF 2025 fund*)
- Rhododendron Control Project (Natura fund*)
- Bird's Nest Swing for Garden of the Senses (Inclusive Sneem – LEADER*)
- Identify Sustainable Urban Drainage Solution (SUDS)
- Community Climate Action Fund - 12 bicycle stands and bicycle repair station
- ICBP solitary bee posts (Pollinator Award)

The CE team cut it back in February and we will be using the cuttings for more dead hedges - this is a great way of dealing with cuttings as it creates great habitat while slowly rotting down.



Tuesday Tidy-Ups

This year's Tidy-up team got to work by cleaning the water filler on the bridge and doing some cutting back in the Wild Garden. We are tackling the invasive Spanish bluebells there by strimming them before they bloom. We also added to our dead hedge. We are always looking for new volunteers. Pollinator Patches - leave a space for wildlife in your garden

- let the grass grow - dandelions are an important food for emerging bees.
- plant a native tree/hedge - willow is especially important for insects
- put in a mini-pond, even a basin with stones and a native mint or other water plant greatly helps wildlife in your garden
- don't use pesticides/herbicides

Hedgecutting

Did you know that under Irish law, hedge cutting is prohibited from 1st March to 31st August? This is to safeguard birds during their nesting season and to protect our precious biodiversity.

Exceptions apply for safety reasons, such as preventing hazards on public roads. However, let's all do our part to cherish and preserve our natural habitats. If you witness illegal hedge cutting, you can report it to your local National Parks and Wildlife Service (NPWS) office.

Cigarette butts

These are the most common forms of litter found on our litter-picks. The bothán in the Wild Garden is a particular blackspot for litter. Despite there being a bin inside the gate, people seem unable to use it so we have added a bin beside the covered seat and a sandbucket right next to the bench - please use them!

A lovely evening on Monday night 3rd March was spent under the stars at Sneem Hotel celebrating Irish Astronomy Week - all were welcome and the event was supported by Kerry Dark Sky Tourism, Caherdaniel Dark Sky Group and the Skellig Coast Dark Sky Festival (27-30 March, info on discoveriveragh.ie)

The evening kicked off with an Irish language astronomy talk with Caoimhín de Bhailís (caoimhinscontent.ie) in Sneem Book Shop. This was followed

by a 'Under One Sky' presentation by Caoimhín in Sneem Hotel. Aoibheann Lambe and Michael Sheehan from the Gold Tier Kerry International Dark Sky Reserve led a discussion on extending the Kerry Dark Sky Reserve to include Sneem. This would involve identifying all sources of outdoor lighting in the area and taking measurements of light impact, then mitigating these by using warmer lights, sensors and shading. Bright lights at night impact moths, bats and other insects as well as blinding us to the wonders of the sky at night. We were fortunate to have such a clear night.
