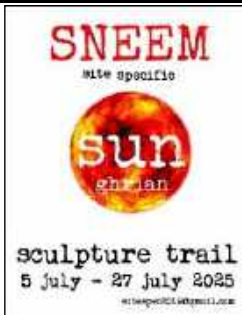

### April Update

This month's meeting of the Sneem Beekeepers brought together a range of valuable information, practical advice, and community connection.

We were pleased to welcome Jane O'Sullivan from Sneem Tidy Towns, who gave an insightful presentation on Ireland's native bumblebees. Jane explained their life cycle, their role in pollination, and the importance of supporting wild pollinators in our local environment. She also brought along a range of information booklets, which are still available through Jane or Sneem Tidy Towns for anyone interested in learning more.

To mark the occasion, club chairperson Myfanwy presented Jane with a small gift of honey and other bee products, produced by our members.

We also heard from Brendan Riney, a long-time member of the group, who gave a detailed talk on early hive inspections. His presentation focused on how to assess hive strength at this time of year and ways to encourage steady colony growth to support honey production later in the season. Brendan's practical knowledge is always appreciated and led to some good discussion among members.

A thank you goes to Sneem Digital Hub for the use of their space for our meeting – it's much appreciated.

Meanwhile, at the Sneem Apiary, new members have begun practical training in hive inspection. This is an important part of their introduction to beekeeping, and we're glad to see such active participation.

We look forward to a productive season ahead and will continue to support each other through learning and collaboration.

## Sneem Sustainable Energy Community



The Sneem SEC (Sustainable Energy Community) held its inaugural Steering Committee meeting on 28th April 2025. A Steering Group had been established in an earlier meeting to drive the project forward.

The purpose of the SEC is to create a community that works together to develop a sustainable energy system for the benefit of the community. The area to be included in this first phase includes the main village of Sneem plus Atlantic Gateway and

the GAA ground.

After a good discussion around what we want to try and achieve, it was agreed that we should move to the next stage of the project which would be the "Planning" stage. This is where we would be looking to apply for an Energy Master Plan (EMP) grant and assign an Energy Master Plan Technical Expert to complete an energy audit of the village. The aim of this is to establish a baseline of existing energy use in the community, to identify a register of energy opportunities, and to outline a strategy to exploit those opportunities.

To assist us moving forward with this we will be holding a further meeting in the coming week with the assigned Mentor, Martin Bealin, from Dingle SEC. We aim to keep the community updated as best as possible on this next stage which may also include holding further public meetings.

## No Mow May

May is a month to lift the spirits, with gardens and green spaces blooming, and bees, butterflies, moths and their caterpillars busying about nectaring, laying eggs and chomping on leaves. We hope that, wherever you are, you get the chance to head out to a wild space to spot some butterflies and bees this month. A huge thank you to everyone who responded to our call to grow not mow this month - great to hear so many people planning to put the mower away this summer, don't forget to get creative with some wiggly paths! Thanks to Roland for painting some new No Mow signs for the village.



## To do this month: Look out for the Orange-tip butterfly and their eggs

If you're lucky enough to have a patch of cuckoo flowers in your garden, take a look under the flowers to see if you can spot a bright orange egg stuck to the stalk. This is the egg of the orange-tip butterfly which feeds on these plants.



**Pollinator Patches** - leave a space for wildlife in your garden

- let the grass grow - dandelions are an important food for emerging bees.
- plant a native tree/hedge - willow is especially important for insects
- put in a mini-pond, even a basin with stones and a native mint or other water plant greatly helps wildlife in your garden
- don't use pesticides/herbicides



**Keep Sneem Village Toxic Chemical Free**

**If you must spray weeds, try our tried and tested Pollinator Friendly Weedkiller**

- One litre white vinegar (extra strong available in Galvin's)
  - One cup of diluted Epsom Salts (available in Sneem Pharmacy)
  - A squirt of washing up liquid.
- Spray onto weeds on a still dry day.

### Bat Emergence Count with Ger McEnery NPWS Monday 19th May at 9.15pm

Meet at Sneem GAA field at 9.15pm, we will be making a 10 minute walk to a known roost for pipistrelle bats where we will sit quietly with bat detectors and counters and record how many bats emerge that evening. This event is weather dependent so won't go ahead if it's raining. Bring a camp stool if you have one, midge nets, wear midge spray and have a head torch. This is an exciting opportunity to learn more about bats and to hear and see them come out at night to feed. Free event but booking is essential. ### Wednesday 21st May at 12pm - Flower-Insect Timed (FIT) Count Workshop

There are concerns that the numbers of pollinating insects such as wild bees and flies are declining, but we need much more data to be able to track changes in abundance. # Kenmare and District Garden Club

The Club met on the 1st May. Our '**5 minute snippet**' was from member, Stephanie Parkes, who spoke about growing a range of unusual tomatoes ('Tomatoes á la Stephanie') and generously provided some free samples of plants.

This month our guest speaker was Mary Catherine Gallagher, an ecologist from Wetlands Surveys which are based here in Kenmare ([www.WetlandSurveys.ie](http://www.WetlandSurveys.ie)) on **Exploring Wetlands:Nature's Water Gardens**. Mary Catherine explained the urgent need for education and action on the part of Ireland, not only to save what little we have left of our wetlands, but to develop our understanding and commitment to attempt to repair some of the damage we have done. Between 1970 and 2015, 35% of our wetlands were lost, three times more than forests lost and currently 25% of plants and animals dependent on wetlands are at risk of extinction. 40% of species rely on wetlands at some point in their life cycles. While all of Europe and beyond have suffered losses of their wetlands also, Ireland seems to have done particularly poorly.

Wetlands include a range of natural forms, such as rivers, springs, bogs, (two kinds: Blanket and Raised); salt marshes such as Kenmare Bay in addition to less well known forms, e.g. Turloughs are unique to Ireland and found mainly in the West of the country in limestone areas. Other wetlands found in Ireland are Wet Grassland, Wet Woodland and Dune Slacks. Other forms, which are not in Ireland, include mangroves and rice paddies.

Wetlands store more carbon than forests and while peatlands occupy 3% of the world they hold 30% of soil carbon.

Mary Catherine explained that the work of restoration is complex and expensive so the importance of protecting what we have is vital. Ireland was a signatory to the Ramsar Convention which came into force in December 1975. This was a global inter-governmental treaty which provided a framework for conservation and wise use of wetlands and their resources.
