Sneem Cardiac First Responder Team Community Appeal

Volunteers Sought to Establish Sneem Cardiac First Responder Team Community Appeal Issued to Help Save Lives in Rural Kerry

Sneem, Co. Kerry – An appeal has been launched to recruit local volunteers to help establish a Cardiac First Responder (CFR) Team in Sneem and the surrounding area. The initiative will be supported and overseen by the Killarney Cardiac Response Unit, which has been serving communities in Kerry with lifesaving emergency response services for over a decade.

The goal is to build a trained team of at least six community members who will be equipped to respond to cardiac arrest, stroke, chest pain, and choking incidents in the vital first minutes before ambulance crews arrive. Once formed and trained, the Sneem CFR Team will be integrated into the National Ambulance Service's 999/112 call-out system.

John Moses, local coordinator for the initiative, is now calling on members of the community to step forward:

"We're looking for people from Sneem and surrounding areas who are willing to volunteer and take part in training. With Killarney CFR's guidance, we'll be building a team that can truly save lives in our local area."

Volunteers will receive full training and ongoing support through the established framework provided by www.killarneycru.ie.

Applications for trees are now open. Trees are available for planting small woodland areas, hedgerows, shelter belts, tree lines, coppice, parkland, agroforestry, orchards and other tree planting scenarios.

Sponsored Trees: There are sponsored tree schemes for schools, colleges, farms, smallholdings, sports clubs and community groups of all kinds. You will find information on these schemes on the application pages of the website.

Gardens: Application Fees: Application Fees apply to all tree packs for gardens and are based on €1.50 per tree. Apple trees are more expensive at €25 each. The smallest tree packs start at €15. Delivery charges of €20 per order apply to all garden tree pack applications.

Application Deadline: Applications for trees will close at 5pm on Tuesday 30th September 2025. This deadline applies to all landowners and tree planting schemes. Please apply promptly to avoid disappointment - we cannot take any late applications. We will close applications early if schemes become oversubscribed - don't leave your application to the last minute! Wild Bees in the Wild Garden - Kerry Wild Bee Festival Outreach Event

We were delighted to host this outreach event during the Sneem Summer Festival following on from our participation in the Kerry Wild Bee Festival last month in Tralee Bay Wetlands. On Friday 18th July, Ger Scollard from the Irish Wildlife Trust - Kerry Branch and Alan Balfe - senior ecologist in Tralee Bay Wetlands led a introduction to wild bees and pollinators in the Wild Garden followed by a Bumblebee Walk up to the Garden of the Senses. We welcomed friends from Transition Kerry and other Tidy Towns groups including Tralee, Ballyduff and Kenmare and would like to thank Kerry County Council and the Heritage Council for their support.



The day stayed fine and there were lots of bees in action. One of the highlights was watching a leafcutter bee carrying a section of leaf into the bee pole in the Garden of the Senses. These solitary bees lay their eggs in the holes and then stuff the entrance with a piece of leaf until the hatched bees emerge. If you spot circles cut out of leaves or flowers, it's possible it's the work of a leafcutter bee. If you watch the bee pole in the Garden of the Senses for a few minutes, you might spot a bee going in with a piece of leaf and then emerging again after she's laid her egg, left some pollen and sealed the section with a piece of leaf.

August's Seeds Feed Next Year's Bees

Long-flowering meadows (one cut and lift a year) are entering an important part of their cycle. Soon, their seeds will drop into the soil and join the seedbank for next year's meadow. Once developed they are fabulous habitats, bursting with native wildflowers and grasses, and supporting an abundance of life above and below ground. If you have a long-flowering meadow, don't cut yet. Wait until September; don't forget to remove the cuttings to reduce soil fertility; and leave some areas totally uncut to help overwintering insects. August's seeds feed next year's bees! Now is also a good time to collect seed from native wildflowers.

FIT Counts

If you're sitting in your garden in August and the sun is shining, spare 10 minutes and become a citizen scientist by carrying out a Flower-Insect Timed Count. Download the app on your phone and follow the instructions – it's easy! There's a 50 x 50cm template available in the Green Chair for marking out your patch. This month, it's especially useful to carry out FIT Counts on Knapweed or Ragwort.

Ger McEnery from NPWS will be carrying out training on treating invasive rhododendron ponticum next Thursday 14th August, meeting at 11am behind the tennis court.

Pollinator Patches - leave a space for wildlife in your garden

- let the grass grow - flowers such as clover provide nectar for bees
- plant a native tree/hedge - willow is especially important for insects
- put in a mini-pond, even a basin with stones and a native mint or other water plant greatly helps wildlife in your garden
- don't use pesticides/herbicides



Keep Sneem Village Toxic Chemical Free. If you must spray weeds, try our tried and tested Pollinator Friendly Weedkiller

- One litre white vinegar (extra strong available in Galvin's)
 - One cup of diluted Epsom Salts (available in Sneem Pharmacy)
 - A squirt of washing up liquid.
- Spray onto weeds on a still dry day.

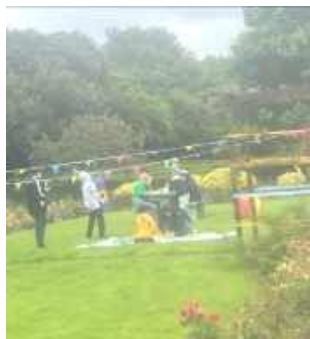
