## Sneem BeeKeepers



The first confirmed nest of the Asian hornet (Vespa velutina) in Ireland was recently found in Cork city. The discovery followed a sighting earlier in August and was quickly dealt with by the Asian Hornet Management Group, working alongside the National Parks and Wildlife Service and other experts.

The Asian hornet is an invasive species that mainly affects wildlife, as it feeds on honeybees, bumblebees, and other pollinators. It is not a danger to the public, but it can put pressure on our local biodiversity if left unmanaged.

For now, the key message is simply to be aware and observant. Any sightings should be reported with a photo so they can be checked by trained teams.


## Parknasilla Golf Club - Ladies Section

## **Rhododendron Control Project**

Following on from training in pesticide and chainsaw use, on 15th August, Ger McEnery from the National Parks and Wildlife Service delivered a training session on invasive rhododendron treatment in Sneem. We had a short presentation in the Little Church and then a practical demonstration on the stand of Rhododendron behind the tennis courts. Ger showed us how to nick each stem near the base with a hatchet and apply a small amount of diluted glyphosate directly into each cut. The addition of blue dye to the herbicide allows you to see where you have carried out the treatment. The group treated the whole stand and now we wait to see it die off. We are planning a trip to join the Killarney Meitheal who clear rhododendron in the National Park. #### To do this month:

If the weather is dry, collect some of your favourite wildflower seeds such as purple loosestrife, knapweed and devil's bit scabious.

Plan to cut and lift your long-flowering meadow. Mid-September is the time when long flowering meadows should be cut, and the grass cuttings removed. Having these meadows, however small, is a fantastic action for biodiversity as it is returning a vital species-rich grassland habitat that has been lost in Ireland.

Remember to leave some areas uncut for overwintering insects.

<u>OVER 65</u>? and *have not received your pneumococcal vaccine*, please contact the surgery for appointment. We need to know in advance to ensure we have the vaccine in stock. This vaccine is available for free to anyone over 65years and is only given once after the age of 65 years. The vaccine is available year round. Pneumococcal vaccine protects against pneumonia, meningitis and sepsis caused by this bacteria. Young children and older adults are most at risk for this infection.






