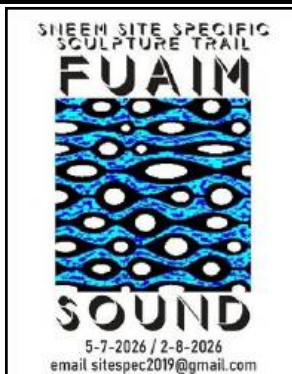

The annual Site Specific Sculpture Trail takes place along the river walks from 5th July to 2nd August 2026.



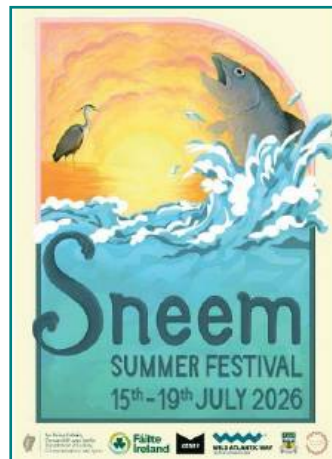

## Local Alert: Proposed Seaweed Harvesting

A 10-year commercial seaweed harvesting application for Kenmare Bay includes the entire Sneem River estuary, meaning our local shoreline would be directly affected. Kenmare Bay is a protected Special Area of Conservation (SAC), and many residents are concerned about the potential impacts on marine habitats and wildlife.

The public consultation has not yet opened, but once announced, there will be only a short period to make submissions. Stay informed by following Friends of Kenmare Bay on Facebook and the MA-RA website for updates.

## Sneem Community First Responders



It has been another busy and rewarding month for Sneem Community First Responders as we continue to develop our skills and strengthen our ability to respond when our community needs us most.

A major focus this month has been our emergency training programme, with volunteers taking part in a series of realistic scenarios across the village. These exercises are designed to recreate the types of incidents we may encounter, allowing the team to practise working together under pressure and ensuring we are ready should a real emergency arise.

These scenarios would not have been possible without the incredible support of our local community. We would like to extend our sincere thanks to **Amanda at Mullen's Ice Cream**, who played the role of a distressed mother during one of the scenarios, **Sean at Dan Murphy's Pub** for his continued support, and **Una and Sue at the Sneem Book Shop** for their enthusiasm and participation. A special thank you also goes to **Sneem Beekeepers** for kindly lending us their gazebo for our community event. The willingness of local businesses and organisations to become actively involved demonstrates the fantastic community spirit that makes Sneem such a special place.

The team also delivered a public CPR and AED demonstration outside Dan Murphy's Pub. It was encouraging to see so many people stop, ask questions and try CPR for themselves. Every additional person who learns these life-saving skills increases the chances of survival for someone experiencing a cardiac arrest.

We are also delighted to celebrate another important milestone. Two members of our team, **Katie** and **John**, have successfully completed their Life Support Instructor training and are now qualified CPR instructors. This is a significant achievement for both of them and for Sneem Community First Responders, as it allows us to expand our training within the local community.

As a result, one of our key objectives over the coming months is to begin offering **FREE CPR awareness and training sessions** to the people of Sneem and our local community. This is our way of saying **thank you** for the outstanding support the community has shown us since the group was established. By equipping more people with the confidence to recognise a cardiac arrest, perform CPR and use a defibrillator, together we can make our community an even safer place to live, work and visit.

### **River Exploration**

The pupils from the Senior Room went on a trip down to the local river with Jessica Mason, who has visited us previously as a part of the Kenmare River Mapping Project. Jessica guided the pupils through a number of activities related to the health and protection of the river. 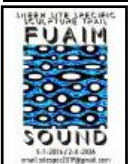

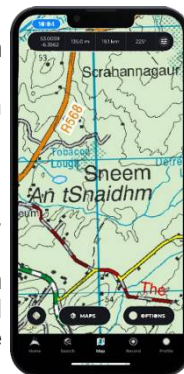

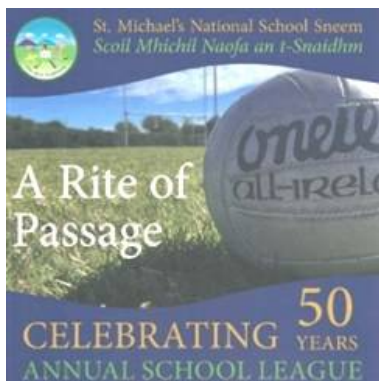
